

"You give them something to eat!"

Luke 9.13 (10-17)

They were, of course, not equipped – the disciples. They didn't have a clue as to how they could possibly feed this crowd. "We have only five loaves of bread and two fish," they said. What they had to offer was too little—so they thought. But this is a story of how God can use our availability to continue to offer help and hope to a hungry world.

One of the hallmarks of Jesus' ministry is compassion. Every encounter Jesus has with hurting people in the gospels is characterized by his compassionate touch. It is this compassion that draws the hurting crowds. Outreach and evangelism, from God's perspective, begins with compassion. I am reminded of the old quip, "People don't care how much you know until they know how much you care."

Compassion will open doors that have been slammed shut by criticism and condemnation. It is medicine for a heart that has been broken or a spirit that has been made cynical. Compassion is the glue that binds a church together. In a world rife with brokenness and sorrow, compassion is one of the most powerful healing forces the Christian community has. When we encounter those who are hungry for hope and help, if we listen carefully, we will still hear the words, "You give them something to eat!"

You and I are Agents of God's Compassion. We are appointed to become for others what Christ has been for us. It does not matter how much you have! What matters most of all is what God can do with what you have! God can take our "not enough" and turn it into "more than enough."

Somewhere in your experience this week, this month, you will see a person or situation where compassion is needed. If you are open to it, you will know in your spirit that God needs an agent of compassion. And when you begin to wonder what can be done for this person -- or in this situation -- the words will come to you:

"You give them something to eat!"


