The new year brings a new opportunity to truly help others. Last year we collected toilet paper as well as paper towels to help support the 3rd Saturday program. This year we are responsible for collecting toilet paper, paper towels, dish soap and spray cleaners for the **PATHWAYS** program. Someone has offered to donate toilet paper and paper towels on a regular basis so you are asked to bring two items. <u>Dish soap and spray cleaners</u> -the type from low price variety stores, e.g., Dollar Stores.

PATHWAYS is a store located in the Maxwell House for the residents which provides items not available with food stamps. The items are available to the residents for donations (suggested prices are much less than low price variety stores, e.g., Dollar Stores). No profit is sought as these items have been graciously donated by several participating churches. Residents are encouraged to make a minimum donations for each item.

The Top Five Objectives of **PATHWAYS** include: 1. In partnership with the residents, **PATHWAYS** intends to fund **EMERGENCY TRANSPORTATION ASSISTANCE (ETA)** for the Maxwell House.

2. Promote personal relationships among those whom we serve that closely resemble a Jesus model of servant-hood.

 Provide opportunities for residents to help other residents. They are passing on a blessing to others.
 Capacity Building: Residents are helped with assuming responsibility for making and changing personal appointments, scheduling and for round trip transportation requirements.

5. Share tangible support to Masters Transport Ministry, a fellow Christian Organization with whom we desire to partner
