Lent?

Not being raised in the Methodist Church I wasn't familiar with the tradition of the Lenten Season. Here are a few short explanations I discover about the features of Lent.

Lent is a time (40 days¹) in which you can use to return to God, refocus our live, and change your lifestyle by building a stronger relationship with God. Jesus would have times where He set himself apart from this earthly world filled with distractions to intentionally spend time with His Father. Luke 5:16 tells us "Jesus Himself would often slip away to deserted places to pray." Jesus set an example for us on how to develop our relationship with the Father. Do you need time alone with God to refocus, make changes and build a stronger relationship with God? Lent is the perfect time.

Why Ashes?

Ashes are a symbol of repentance and to remind us of our mortality.

"Then the LORD God formed a man from dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul." Genesis 2:7

The shape of the cross is used to remind us that Jesus Christ gave us eternal life.

John 3:16 "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life."

Fasting, Prayer & Service?

According to Wikipedia fasting is a willing abstinence or reduction from some or all food, drink, or both for a period of time. Fasting is found in several places in scripture². The time that would have been spent in food prep and eating can now be spent in prayer building your relationship with God. You could try a fast from your phone, entertainment or just get your mind off of self and serve others. Check with Pastor Jim for ways to serve in our community.

Did you know Lent has a colour?

Purple is used for two reasons: firstly because it is associated with mourning and so anticipates the pain and suffering of the crucifixion, and secondly because **purple** is the colour associated with royalty, and celebrates Christ's resurrection and sovereignty.³

Are You Kidding Me?


