I don't even know where or how I happened to get the book, but when I was ten years old I read it—devouring the pages, re-reading it over again. In fact, I read it so many times that I could quote passages from it.

What was the book that so captured my interest that hot, Indiana summer? It was the book, "Crazy Legs McBain"— a story about a football team that had suffered a devastating loss when a championship bound football team lost most of its members in a tragic airplane crash. Hal McBain, the main character, was a lanky student who always dreamed of playing football, but was denied the opportunity. The beleaguered coach—desperate for players—recruits Hal for the team. The team members help Hal learn, encouraging him, urging him on as he learns that daydreams become reality only with hard work.

It was my type of story—the ultimate underdogs-overcoming-the-worstthat-can-happen type of story. A story when the good guys win! A story when the most unlikely hero and team goes on to victory against impossible odds. A story when persistence, hard work, and team work carry the day. It's also a story when friendship and integrity are all important.

Who doesn't love a story like that? The message of that story hold true for the church today.

Persistence. Hard work. Teamwork. Loyalty. Encouragement. Integrity. All these come into play as we try to live as followers of Jesus Christ. It's only as we work together that we can be the very best that we can be-Christ for the world. It's God's love for us and our love for each other that carries us on to victory. May we remember the words written to the early church:

Hebrews 10:24-25 "Let us be concerned for one another, to help one another to show love and to do good. Let us not give up the habit of meeting together, as some are doing. Instead, let us encourage one another all the more, since you see that the Day of the Lord is coming nearer."
