**Clean Ups**

(12) Wet Clothing. Children's wet or soiled clothing shall be stored in individual plastic bags immediately after being removed from the child.

Because of the above statement that is in the rules and regulations of the Bright From the Start Handbook we reserve the right to throw away any clothes we deem are too soiled to send home with a child.

The Woodlawn Preschool and Child Development Center reserves the right to deny services to a particular child or parent if:

Behavior problems continue and cause other children to not get the attention they need or prevent the teachers from doing their jobs consistently.

VBS: Vacation Bible School starts Monday July 15th.

Chapel: We will not have chapel for the summer. Chapel will resume in September.

Vacation: All children receive one half rate per year as a vacation week. Therefore parents are required to pay half of that week's tuition. All other weeks require full payment whether your child is in attendance or not. Vacation weeks should be paid for before you leave for vacation so that you do not incur a \$50.00 late charge.

Parent Incentives: Did you know that for every family you refer to the preschool you can get \$50.00 off of one week of tuition for your child. All you have to do is refer a family and they enroll and stay for 8 weeks. Please see Ms. Brenda if you have any questions or if you have already referred a family but have not received your incentive payment.

Older siblings in infant rooms: Parents if at all possible please take the older children to their class first. This will cut down on the amount of traffic in the infant rooms it will also decrease germs being introduced in the rooms. The infants have the weakest immune systems of all of the children in the center. This is an effort to keep them well. Parents when entering the rooms please do not walk on the mats on the floor. Remember we are striving to give the best possible care to all of our children enrolled in our center.

Sick Children: I try really hard not to bother parents at work; however, if you are called to pick your child up please pick your child up within 30 minutes. We do not have a place to put sick children therefore it is imperative that you get here as soon as possible.

July 4: The center will be closed July 4<sup>th</sup> in observance of Independence Day.
