THANK YOU SO MUCH FOR ALLOWING US TO BE A PART OF YOUR CHILD'S EARLY LEARNING YEARS.

Children in the hall: All children must be escorted to and from their classrooms at all time. Please do not let your child run down the hall without you. This is both a safety issue and a Bright From the Start rule.

Tuition: Remember that tuition payments are due on Monday of each week. However, you have until Wednesday of that week to pay without a late fee. If you pay after the close of business on Wednesday your account will assess a late fee of \$50.00. You can make a payment in cash, check, money order, credit card, debit card or pay pal. Calling me does not mean you will not get a late fee.

Warm Weather: We are required by Bright From the Start to take the children outdoors at least one and one half hours per day if the weather permits. Please be sure to bring your child a hat and sunscreen. The children love to play outside but sometimes they require extra products to help prevent sunburn.

Parent Agreement: Parents when you enroll your children into Woodlawn you agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the center and Bright From the Start. One of Woodlawn's rules is that all children are to be at school no later than 9:30am. This rule has been pushed to the limit by some parents. We cannot have children coming to school at all times of the day. It is not conducive to a healthy learning environment.

Sick Children: Parents there are a few times when we ask you to pick up your child and you cannot bring your child back to school the next day. Those times are as follows: diarrhea, temperature of 101 or higher and must be fever free for at least 24 hours, rash (suspected contagious disease, draining skin lesions and vomiting). Please keep these in mind so that we do not have to send you home the next day. If you bring your child to school the following day you will be called to come and pick them up.

Reminders: It is required by Bright From the Start that all children have a sheet and blanket at naptime every day.

*All children are required to have a change of clothes also.

*We request that all personal toys be left at home. They cause problems in the classroom.

*We request that the children eat the lunch that is provided for them at the preschool unless they do not eat certain foods due to religious or dietary reasons. We must serve healthy lunches and snacks to comply with The Child and Adult Food Program (CACFP).

*We are beginning to experience some warm weather and we ask that the children do not wear crocs or flip flops unless they have a strap around the heel of their feet. Otherwise these shoes cause the children to fall more often than they already do.

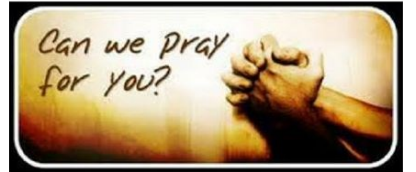
