July 4: The center will be closed July 4th in observance of Independence Day.

Vacation: All children receive one half rate per year as a vacation week after being enrolled for at least six months. Your child can not attend school that week. Therefore parents are required to pay half of that week's tuition. If it is not paid before you go on vacation you will incur a late fee for the week. All other weeks require full payment whether your child is in attendance or not.

Parking: Please turn your car off before bringing your child into the center. It is quite dangerous to leave cars running unattended.

Sheets and blankets for cots: It is mandatory by Bright From The Start that all children have sheets and blankets at nap time. The preschool will be written up if our consultant comes in and find that some children do not have these two items. Please be sure that your child has these items daily.

VBS: July 15th though July 19th is the week of Vacation Bible School.

Signing in and out: It is very important to us that we keep our attendance correct each day. If for some reason your finger does not work please stop by the office and let us retake your fingerprint. Please pay close attention to the bottom right hand corner of the screen. There you will see how much is owed for the week. If you have any questions please see Ms. Tamekia.

Parent Incentives: Did you know that for every family you refer to the preschool you can get \$50.00 off of one week of tuition for your child. All you have to do is refer a family and they enroll and stay for 4 weeks. Please see Ms. Tamekia if you have any questions or if you have already referred a family but have not received your incentive money.

2019-2020 School Year: As you know Richmond County children will return to school this year on August 7th. We try to go by their schedule but this year our K3 and PreK classes will officially start August 19th. The lead teachers in those two rooms will let you know what to expect for the upcoming school year.

Parents Picking Up Children: Please be sure that you make the teacher aware that you are taking your child. Remember we are responsible for the children until they are picked up.

Teacher Work Day: The center will be closed on August 2nd.

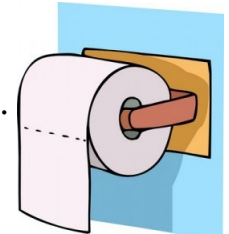

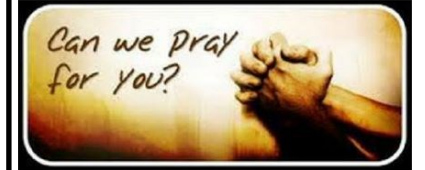
When I was a child, time was almost nonexistent. I was in a constant state of just being, in relationship with my parents, my siblings. My world around me was ripe with discovery and opportunity. Running, singing, playing—each day was a seamless movement of one thing to another. I seemed more connected to the world around me—lying on the ground face first in the grass, inhaling the scent of damp earth. A ride on the way home from church was the fun of lying down in the back seat (this was before seatbelts and car seats!) looking up through the rear window, marveling at the street lights against a dark sky, feeling with my body the thump of the tires against the road.
