There are several notes to be made aware of as well as activities as we get into 2020!

Tuition Rate Increase: Monday, January 6th, marks the beginning of our new Tuition Rates. Please find the rates that apply to your child below:

- **Infants** - \$157.00
- **Toddlers & Two's** - \$152.00
- **3's, K-3, Transition & Pre-K** - \$147.00

Blankets/Sheets: Please make sure that your child's blankets and sheets are in the appropriate condition. This is a state requirement, and if not maintained, can be a safety hazard.

Morning Drop-Off: Please be sure that your children are dropped off at the preschool **no later than 9:30am**. If you know that you will be dropping your child off later than 9:30am please let us know prior and if circumstances apply, bring a doctor's note.

Winter Clothing: Winter is here! As we go through this winter season, please make sure that your children have the proper clothes for the weather!

Staffing: The Woodlawn Preschool Committee is still working on hiring full-time teachers, as well as continuing the search for a Director! Thank you to everyone for being patient with us during this time of transition.

Terrific Tuesdays: Our Terrific Tuesday program is back for the New Year and for a New Time! Beginning January 14th, we will be picking up with our Terrific Tuesday program, and it will begin at 6:00pm now! This will give everyone time to get the family and join us for an evening of fun, fellowship, and worship!

Entering/Exiting The Preschool: Please be sure when picking up and dropping off your children, that you enter through the front doors of the Preschool.

Please refrain from using the back door as this can be a safety hazard.

This is a precaution for the safety of you and your children.

Sick Children: When you receive a call from the center that your child is ill, please make arrangements to pick them up **within one hour**. For protection and Health of the other children, staff and parents, **PLEASE DO NOT** bring your child to the center if they have had any of the symptoms below in the last 24 hours:

Diarrhea, a temperature of 101 or higher and (suspected contagious disease) vomiting. The child may not return to school the following day, and must be symptom free at least 24 hours. The center reserves the right to request a doctor's note before admitting a child back into the center.

Monday, January 20th - Martin Luther King Jr. Day **(CLOSED)**

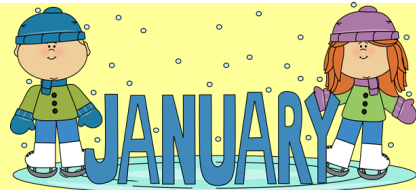

"Oh give thanks to the LORD, for he is good, for his steadfast love endures forever!" (Psalm 107:1)

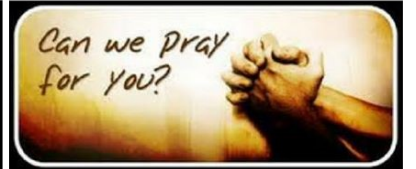
"I will recount the Lord's faithful acts; I will sing the Lord's praises, because of all the Lord did for us.. (Isaiah 63:7)
