If you must leave a bag with the car-seat for any reason, it must be totally empty.

Clothes: Please make sure that your children have a season appropriate change of clothes in their cubby at all times!

Sheets/Blankets: Please make sure that you are taking your child's sheets and blankets home on Friday of every week to launder them. Also, please be aware that sheets and blankets cannot have any holes or tears in them, as this can be a safety hazard to the children. Be sure to check your child's sheets and blankets for holes and tears!

CPR/Fire Safety/First Aid Training: Woodlawn will be offering a CPR, Fire Safety, and First Aid Training at 5:30PM on Wednesday, March 4th. This class is open to the public for anyone who needs to receive these trainings! There is a \$40 fee to receive all three, and a \$20 fee for each individual course.

Easter Egg Hunt: Woodlawn Preschool will have their annual Easter Egg Hunt on Thursday, April 2nd @ 5:30PM! The preschool will close at 5:00PM to give us time to prepare for the hunt!

I have learned over the years that Providence is always a whole lot wiser than any of us and that there are always not only good reasons, but the very best reasons for the delays and blocks that often seem to us so frustrating and absurd.”


Oh yes, I like this quote. I even have it written in my journal.
