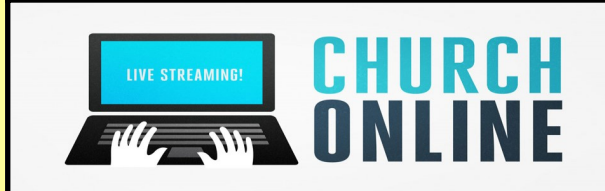
Friday, July 3rd - The Woodlawn Preschool will be closed on Friday, July 3rd, in observance of The 4th of July Holiday.

Boxes and more boxes.

My office is filled with boxes.

And those boxes will be filled with books, pictures, and items that I've accumulated throughout my ministry. I've got collections of angels, crosses, and coffee mugs that people have given me over the years. Many of those people have passed away but I'm surrounded by the memories of the camaraderie, the laughter and tears, the cups of coffee as we fellowshiped together.

I've cleaned out the file cabinets and I have a couple of stacks of boxes filled with sermons—many that I've preached here at Woodlawn. Since I've made a point not to preach the same sermon word for word twice, my collection of sermons have grown over the years.

I considered tossing them; after all, I have most of them saved on thumb drives. So why do I keep them? Well, for one thing, my daughter says that the hard copies are the ones I've actually preached and they have my handwritten, last minute changes. They are something I've handled. (She didn't say it, but they will be precious after I've gone on to my reward!) For me, though, I am keeping them because of the sermon illustrations. They are a record of what was happening in my life over the years because I have a tendency to draw on my own life experiences when I preach. In those boxes are stories of when the children were small, of life events such as teaching a teenager how to drive or becoming a grandmother. Those boxes contain a record of my own faith journey, my own struggles with difficult scripture. Those sermons are a record of the sweat, tears and prayer as I struggled through my own questions and doubts.

I've figured it up: I've preached approximately 1000 times, not counting special services or when I served as an associate.

As I ponder those sermons, I can almost guarantee that if I read through all of them again, there would be certain words that would come up over and over and over again: grace, goodness, mercy, forgiveness, blessing, love.

It's not surprising since those words are the foundation of my own faith: God's grace, goodness, mercy, forgiveness, blessing and love.

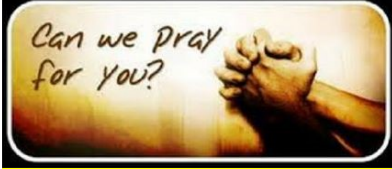
To quote Robert Devall: "These are the things worth believing in." * I pray that that the message has gotten through!
