We will also be planning for the time when our church building re-opens, (because the congregation will gather together again!) following the guidelines given to us by the Conference.

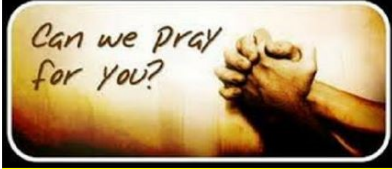
In the meantime, consider the words of St. Paul in Ephesians 5:18b-20
