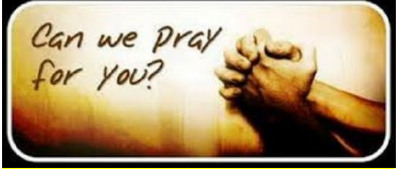
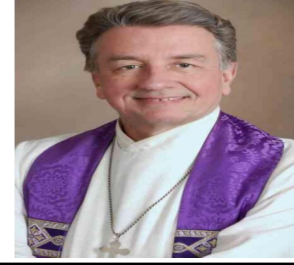
HYMN OF PROMISE:
