**Solve Funding:** If your child is enrolled in virtual learning please contact the office **immediately** to request special funding that can assist you with tuition. There is a limited time that this can be applied for.

**Pre-K/Virtual Learning:** All students enrolled in these programs, if they are planning to have breakfast, must be here between **8am & 8:30am**. If they arrive after 8:30am, they will have to wait until lunch. Your child's academic day begins **promptly at 8:30am**. We are responsible for recording weekly attendance, tardies, and absences. 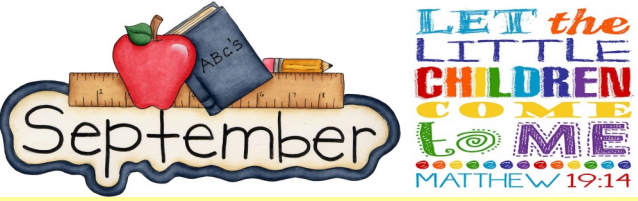

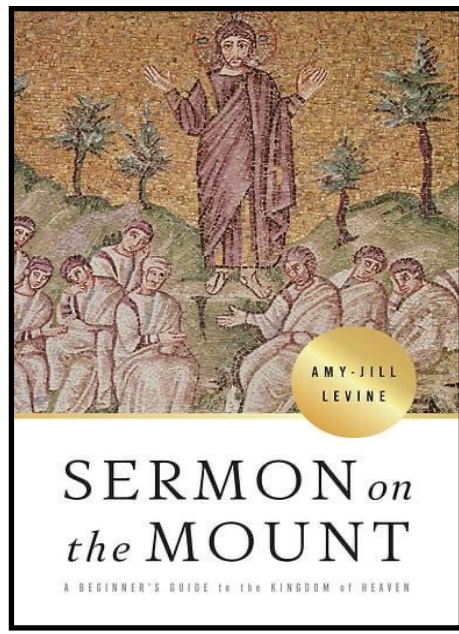

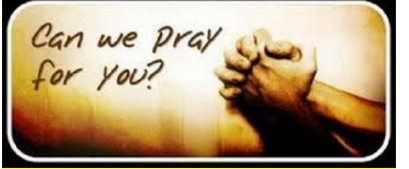
