

### Annual Conference 2023 Report North Georgia Annual Conference

The 2023 Annual Conference session was held June 1-3 in Athens, GA, with Bishop Robin Dease presiding. Approximately 2,000 United Methodists gathered for the session under the theme "I will pour out my spirit on all," based on Joel 2:28. Together we worshiped, shared meals, deliberated, sang, prayed, and carried out the work of the church.

Among the highlights of the session were:

- Powerful worship, music, and sermons,
- The posthumous ordination of Rev. Marita Harrell, who died tragically as a result of violence,
- Honoring the saints who have gone before us, including our former pastor, Rev. Mary Kollarik,
- Adoption of the lowest apportionment budget in 22 years,
- Celebrating that the Barnes Fund awarded \$1,388,622 in grants to local churches, districts, and conference boards and agencies in 2022 (in 2023 the Barnes Fund is on track to invest \$1,272,370 in mission and ministry across our Annual Conference),
- Introduction to the Lighthouse Church initiative and introduction of our conference-wide strategic growth plan,
- Electing new boards and committees, and
- Licensing, commissioning, and ordaining new servant leaders who are called and quipped to serve God's holy church.

## What Is Our Biblical Story?

United Methodist Christians affirm the authority of the Holy Bible as the source of our understanding about God and God's relationship with us.

#### The Bible Moths

In 1729, three young men at Oxford University gathered together in a dorm room to read the Bible. These seekers then invited a twenty-three-year-old professor and newly ordained priest in the Church of England to lead their Bible Study for the next six years. The bright, intense scholar was John Wesley. Around the



raucous university town, other students called the group "Bible Moths," because the hovered over the Scriptures like moths around a flame. Another name, based on their methodical pattern of biblical study, prayer, fasting, and service stuck: Methodists. John Wesley distributed a pamphlet entitled "The Character of a Methodist," in which he described the people called Methodist:

"The distinguishing marks of Methodists are not their opinions of any sort. Their assenting to this or that scheme of religion, embracing any particular set of notions, espousing the judgement of one person or of another, are all quite wide of the point.... We believe the written word of God to be the only and sufficient rule both of Christian faith and practice.... We believe Christ to be the eternal, supreme God.... But as to all opinions which do not strike at the root of Christianity, we think and let think. So that whatsoever they are, whether right or wrong, they are no distinguishing marks of Methodists."

Wesley did not begin his ministry to create something unique. He neither advocated a peculiar way of being Christian nor intended to form a new Christian denomination. Wesley simply listened to the Bible and did what God commanded. Nevertheless, that gathering of eighteenth-century young adults, who studied the Bible and walked in the footsteps of Jesus, marked the beginning of a huge movement. Over the past two and a half centuries, this movement has changed millions of lives and transformed the world in significant ways.
